(Flushing – September, 2009) – Kupferberg Center Performances opens its 2009-10 classical concert series with **Chamber Orchestra Kremlin** on Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup> at 2 PM. The following program will be performed in the intimate setting of the LeFrak Concert Hall:

**Elgar/Serenade in E minor, Op.20  
Shostakovich/Chamber Symphony, Op. 110 bis  
Bach/Contrapunctus No.1 from the Art of the Fugue  
Dvorak/Serenade for Strings, Op.22**

Chamber Orchestra Kremlin, comprising some of Russia's finest young string players, has earned national and international recognition as one of Russia's leading ensembles. Founded in 1991, the orchestra has carved a niche for itself under the creative baton of its founder and music director Misha Rachlevsky. Of nine hundred compositions in the orchestra's repertoire, over 20 were written especially for the orchestra by composers from Russia, Europe and the USA.

Chamber Orchestra Kremlin's highly acclaimed CDs and its mesmerizing concerts emanate warmth and high energy that create addictive performances that stay with listeners long after the last note has been played. *The Kansas City Star* raves, "Chamber Orchestra Kremlin, 18 young string players from Moscow, dispensed dazzling finesse but also rich musical—indeed, emotional—expression." *The New York Times* states, "Misha Rachlevsky, the ensemble's music director, elicited warm, full-blooded and virtuosic playing with colorfully shaped, gleaming phrases."

With eighteen years of excellence under its belt and an awards-winning catalog of over thirty CDs, Chamber Orchestra Kremlin enthusiastically maintains its busy schedule of recording and presenting concerts and festivals in Moscow, and touring regularly in North and South America, Europe and the Far East.
